How to Get Certified

Step 1
Review Eligibility
Requirements

Determine how many of the BWC requirements your residential site currently meets.



Step 2
Get Your
Designation

Work with the pointA team to implement commuting programs that meet your tenant's needs and fulfill the requirements of the designation. Apply for the designation between June and November each year.



Step 3
Get Recognized

Every January, the list of BWC workplaces, sites, residential sites, universities and colleges is released on the BWC website and your workplace will be recognized across North America.

The Road to Becoming a BWC - Best Residential Site

To qualify, identify the transportation benefits that you offer or would like to offer at your residential site. From the checklist below, you must offer **one primary benefit and three secondary benefits** to qualify. Contact info@pointa.ca for details about designation requirements.



- Transit Pass (\$30+/resident who commutes)
- Shuttle Service (must be fully or partially funded by site)
- Bicycle Commuting (reduces commuting trips by 6%+ or \$20+/month/commuter)
- Carpool Subsidy (\$30+/carpooler/month)
- Commuter Kiosk
- Unbundled Parking
- Equivalent Benefit
