## How to Get Certified

**Step 1**  
Review Eligibility  
Requirements

Determine how many of the BWC requirements your university currently meets.



**Step 2**  
Get Your  
Designation

Work with the pointA team to implement commuting programs that meet your employees' needs and fulfill the requirements of the designation. Apply for the designation between June and November each year.



**Step 3**  
Get Recognized

Every January, the list of BWC workplaces, sites, residential sites, universities and colleges is released on the BWC website and your workplace will be recognized across North America.

# The Road to Becoming a BWC - Best University

To qualify, identify the transportation benefits that you offer or would like to offer at your organization. From the checklist below, you must offer **one primary benefit, three secondary benefits and all support benefits** to qualify. - Transit Pass Subsidy (\$30+/month/employee OR student)
- Carpool/Vanpool Subsidy (\$30+/month/employee OR Student)
- Cash Instead of Parking (\$30+/month/employee)
- Employee OR Student Shuttle (must be fully or partially funded by institution)
- Remote Work Program (reduces commuting trips by 6%+)
- Compressed Workweek (reduces commuting trips by 6%+)
- Bicycle Commuting Program (reduces commuting trips by 6%+ or \$20+/month/employee OR student)
- Equivalent Commuter Benefit
